This is a wonderful opportunity to visit Pengenna Manor, an ancient house and popular wedding venue with a fascinating history.



Richard Blewett, the current owner of the estate, is the sixth generation of his family to live at the manor, will give us an exclusive behind-the-scenes tour of the house and its 800 years of fascinating history. Having spent over 20 years researching Pengenna's past, Richard brings the story of the manor to life with his deep knowledge and personal insight. We will visit rarely seen areas

including those parts as yet unrestored and he will answer any of our questions.
